### **ARISE project (Anti-Racism In Schools and Education) Staff training and Assemblies**

This week we have all been learning about the effects that racism in many forms can have on members of our community and the wider world. Mpula, from the ARISE project led our weekly staff meeting on Monday offering useful insight into the effects of racism and also strategies on how we can continue to promote respect for others as part of the British Values that we advocate. On Wednesday the children enjoyed interactive assemblies which gave them time to recognise acts of racism, how these affect people and what can be done to educate each other and make the change.
