 WWII (History) Rationing Recipe Booklet: Research WWII rationing and create a short recipe booklet using ingredients from that time.	 WWII (History) WWII Fact File: Choose one aspect (e.g. The Blitz, Evacuation, Codebreaking) and create a one-page fact file or poster.	 Biomes and Our World in the Future (Geography) Biome in a Box: Create a shoebox model of a biome (rainforest, desert, tundra, etc.), including climate, animals, and plants.	 Biomes and Our World in the Future (Geography) Climate Detective: Research how climate change could affect your local area in 50 years. Present as a poster or slideshow.
 Fairground Rides (Design Technology) Design a Ride: Sketch your own fairground ride, labeling the forces involved (e.g., gravity, friction) and safety features.	 Fairground Rides (Design Technology) Model Maker: Build a mini fairground ride using materials like LEGO, cardboard, or K'NEX, and explain how it moves.	 Spreadsheets and e-Safety (Computing) E-Safety Comic Strip: Create a comic strip that shows a situation involving online safety and how to handle it responsibly.	Painting and Mixed Media (Art) Artist Inspired: Research a mixed media artist and recreate a small piece inspired by their style using materials at home.
 Cricket and Athletics (PE) PE Poster: Design a motivational poster encouraging children to try cricket or athletics (or other sports), with tips and benefits.	 Sikhism (Multi-faith/RE) Sikh Stories: Illustrate a Sikh moral story or parable and explain the lesson it teaches.	 Jubilee Year of Hope Hope Challenge: Complete 5 small acts of kindness (helping at home, cheering someone up, picking up litter) and write about how they made you feel.	 Jubilee Year of Hope Hope Around the World: Find out how different cultures or religions express hope. Present this as a booklet or video.
