This can be real like under the sea or imaginary like an enchanted forest. Experiment with different mediums e.g. pastels, felt tips collage etc.	Chinese New Year 2025 - the year of the Snake. Research and find out about Chinese New year and the significance of the Year of the Snake.	
<u>DT</u> Linked to Science – reuse materials such as cardboard boxes, kitchen rolls, newspapers and yoghurt pots to create your own junk model. This can link to another subject e.g. a model version of your setting or be something of your choice!	<b>Geography</b> Find out about Chinese paper cuts, traditional Chinese stories and more aspects of the Chinese Culture.	<u>RE</u> Retell one of the parables in your own words. It could be a story, diary or Letter.	<u>Geography / DT</u> Construct your own Great Wall of China using Lego or recycled boxes. Take a photo and email it to the school office.
