You can use: <i>Spring</i>: Draw or cut out flowers, birds, and trees with new leaves. <i>Summer</i>: Use bright colors for the sun, beach items, or ice creams. <i>Autumn</i>: Use oranges, yellows, and browns for leaves and pumpkins. <i>Winter</i>: Use white, blue, and silver for snow, snowflakes, and bare trees. These can be glued onto a large poster board or piece of paper and then you could label each section with the season.</p>
